

## **North Ayrshire Councillors act on climate change**

**Community Windpower Ltd is delighted to announce that North Ayrshire Council yesterday voted to approve the Millour Hill Community Windfarm planning application in a positive commitment to tackling climate change.**

As the UN Climate Change Conference in Copenhagen continues and government leaders discuss how to reduce greenhouse gas emissions for developed and developing countries along with measures on adaptation to climate change, the North Ayrshire Planning Committee sat down and discussed the proposed Millour Hill Community Windfarm.

After detailed debate, the Committee voted to approve the 6 turbine windfarm which will stand on Baidland Hill adjacent to the existing Dalry Community Windfarm also owned by Community Windpower Ltd.

Rod Wood, Director for Community Windpower Ltd said “This is a great decision and we are pleased that North Ayrshire Council has taken another positive step in continuing to support renewable energy in the region, Millour Hill Community Windfarm will aid the fight to reduce carbon emissions in Scotland and tackle climate change”.

Millour Hill Community Windfarm will generate 18MW of clean, green electricity and construction work will utilise the existing access road used during the construction of Dalry Community Windfarm.
